

ORDINANCE NO. 51 - 79

An Ordinance to authorize the purchase of group term life insurance for all full time municipal employees, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of group term life insurance for all full time municipal employees, said insurance shall be in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) for each full time municipal employee under seventy (70) years of age, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisements according to law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, because said insurance needs to be bid in a timely manner so as to be included in the 1980 employee benefits, and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
