ORDINANCE NO. 52-79

By:

An ordinance to establish a Capital Improvements Fund for the City of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the City of Bexley has annually passed a Capital Improvements ordinance setting aside and appropriating money from the General Fund and others for the specific capital projects to be undertaken during the fiscal year in question.

Section 2: That the capital projects, as distinguished from the annual operating expenditures, have been consequently contingent on funds available which has impeded long-range planning and programs that span nore than one fiscal year.

Section 3: That it is the desire of this Council to establish and maintain a special Capital Improvements Fund to be able to spend money in the following areas:

- street resurfacing, repairs,
- alley resurfacing, repairs,
- 3. trucks, cars, and equipment,
- 4. land and building acquisition,
- 5. street light improvements,
- 6. park improvements,
- 7. trucks, bins, and packers,
- 8. other Capital Improvements financed from general revenues

in order to develop and implement a long-range Capital Improvements Program.

Section 4: That the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to establish a Capital Improvements Fund which shall be funded from time to time by appropriations from the unencumbered General Fund and from other general revenues.

Section 5: That the sum of \$1,200,000 be and it is hereby transferred from the General Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund to be used in the manner and for the purposes set forth above.

Section 6: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare in said City, said emergency arising from the fact that the appropriations and transfers are needed to finance vital city projects and protect the credit of said city; therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
