An Ordinance to make appropriations for capital improvements during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1980.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following sum be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered Gneral Fund for use for the Recreation and Parks Department:

(a) \$6,000.00 for the purchase of a new one-half ton pickup truck; AND ACCESSORIES,

(b) \$6,000.00 for the purchase of a new riding mower and snow blade AND ACCESSORIES.

Section 2. That the following sum be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Fund for use for the Service Department:

(a) \$18,000.00 for the purchase of a new bucket type sewer cleaner AND ACCESSORIES,

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the purchase of the necessary equipment and materials specifically identified in the previous two (2) sections, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sums so specified and appropriated in each section, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 4. Said contracts shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 5. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
