

ORDINANCE NO. 4 -80

An ordinance to appropriate funds and authorize the purchase of a new 1979 or 1980 Van for use by the Water Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$7,000 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered Water and Sewer Fund for the purpose of purchasing a new 1979 or 1980 Van ^{and accessories} for use by the Water Department.

Section 2: That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter a purchase contract for said item, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum so specified and appropriated, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the Office of the Mayor, and shall include 110 inch wheel base, a V-8 engine, power brakes and steering, automatic transmission and side and rear doors.

Section 3: That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4: That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
