

ORDINANCE NO. 10 -80

An ordinance to make additional appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures of the City during the fiscal year 1980 and to supplement Ordinance 1-80 and other appropriations ordinances.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1: That the following sums be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund of the City and transferred to the Fund and for the purpose indicated:

- (a) The sum of \$3,600 to the Police Department Fund for Special equipment to be used to purchase revolvers, ammunition, and photographic equipment;
- (b) The sum of \$5,000 to the Police Department Fund to amend and increase the amount appropriated for five (5) police cruisers from \$30,000 to \$35,000 to provide for the purchase of necessary accessory equipment to make the new police cruisers operational;
- (c) The sum of \$3,000 to City Hall to provide for repairs and for furnace, air conditioning and roof maintenance;
- (d) The sum of \$2,700 to Other Parks Fund, \$1,200 of which is to be used for stump removal and \$1,500 of which is to be used for supplies and materials.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
