

RESOLUTION No. 14-80

WHEREAS, Franklin County Children Services is responsible for the delivery of a multitude of protective services to the children of this County; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Children Services will be unable to meet its current level of services, and further will be unable to increase its level of services in the future, without additional revenue; and

WHEREAS, State and Federal funding which has been relied upon in the past is tentative and uncertain; and

WHEREAS the Franklin County Board of Commissioners has approved a Franklin County Children Services request to place a 0.85 mill levy on the ballot in November, 1980;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio, publicly endorses the proposed 0.85 mill tax levy so that the optimum delivery of services by Franklin County Children Services may be continued to enhance the quality of life of the dependent and neglected children of Franklin County.
