ORDINANCE NO. 18 -80

An ordinance to authorize the purchase of portable radios for the Police Department pursuant to the requirements of the Communication Project Plan submitted to the Columbus-Franklin County Criminal Justice Coordinating Council and approved by that agency, effective 2/11/80, and to appropriate money subject to reimbursement from the agency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Bexley Police Department has submitted a Communication Project to the Regional Planning Unit (RPU), essentially seeking to obtain portable radios, or walkietalkies, for improved local police communication, which project has now been approved at a total cost of \$16,000 of which \$14,400 will be provided by Federal funds through the RPU and \$800 by the State Buy-In which will be funded by the RPU;

will have to provide one-eighteenth (1/18) of the Federal share or \$800 as the Local Share of the project; however, the funding is awarded on a reimbursement basis, so that the City of Bexley must first purchase or contract to purchase the equipment from its own funds before reimbursement of 90% or \$14,400 can be sought or obtained from the RPU;

Section 3: That the grant provided for from the Columbus-Franklin County Criminal Justice Coordinating Council, Regional Planning Unit, is accepted, that the project as submitted is hereby approved, and that Mayor is hereby authorized and designated to execute the necessary documents implementing the acceptance on behalf of the City of Bexley;

Section 4: That pursuant to the specifications of the proposal submitted and accepted by the RPU, the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into contracts for the purchase of radio equipment identified and specified in the project proposal, which contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law,

Section 5: That the sum of \$16,000, the total project cost, shall be and it is hereby appropriated and set aside from the General Fund to pay for the equipment and that as soon as the equipment is purchased or contracted for and the exact cost of the equipment is known, that Form LE 102-69 be completed and returned to the Columbus-Franklin County Criminal Justice Coordinating Council for reimbursement of 90% of the equipment cost or \$14,400, whichever is less;

Section 6: That this Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
