

ORDINANCE NO. 20 -80

An ordinance to appropriate funds for the clothing allowance previously authorized for supervisory personnel.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That in Schedule II of Ordinance 2-80, this Council specifically authorized a clothing allowance of \$200.00 per year for boots, gloves, parkas, and other clothing required of the job for the following named personnel:

- (a) Superintendent of Maintenance
- (b) Superintendent of Streets and Service
- (c) Superintendent of Parks
- (d) Parks Supervisor
- (e) Superintendent of Water Service
- (f) Assistant Service Director
- (g) Assistant to the Mayor

Section 2: That no funds were set aside for such purpose in the appropriations ordinance at the time and therefore the sum of \$1,400.00 should be, and it is, hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to be used to pay for such clothing allowance in the manner set forth in the authorizing legislation.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
