

ORDINANCE NO. 22-80

An ordinance to appropriate funds to reimburse a property owner for sewer repairs caused by excavation for the Bexley Streetlighting Project.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That in excavating for the Bexley Streetlighting Project, apparently during October 1979, the sanitary sewer lateral on Park Hill Drive had been cut completely in half eventually causing sewer problems at the residence of Henry M. O'Neill, Jr. at 2077 Park Hill Drive necessitating emergency service and repairs to clean the mud and debris from the house;

Section 2: That such service was performed by Rescue Rooter Sewer Company who had been originally called to the property by the owner, but was specifically authorized by the Service Department of the City;

Section 3: That the amount of \$307.00 was billed to Mr. O'Neill for the services and paid by him and that he should be reimbursed for this expenditure by the City;

Section 4: That the sum of \$307.00 should be and it is, hereby set aside, and appropriated from the Sewer Fund and the Auditor is hereby authorized to pay that amount to the property owner, or to his account, whichever is appropriate, and is hereby authorized to seek reimbursement of that same amount from the Streetlight Project Fund and/or the Streetlight Project contractor which caused the damage;

Section 5: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
