

ORDINANCE NO. 25-80

An ordinance to appropriate funds and authorize the Mayor to contract for engineering services and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$2,000.00 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered Water and Sewer Fund for the purpose of conducting a sanitary sewer flow measurement study and preparing preliminary design plans for a sanitary relief sewer.

Section 2: That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Jennings-Lawrence Company for said study, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum so specified and appropriated.

Section 3: That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
