

ORDINANCE NO. 27-80

Authorizing the negotiation of a contract for the purchase of thermoplastic pavement marking materials for use on East Main Street and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of thermoplastic pavement marking material to be used on East Main Street. The plans and specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor. The total cost of the project is not to exceed \$25,000.00.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law, and that said amount has been authorized for this project by the Franklin County Commissioners under the Franklin County \$5.00 Permissive License Tax Program.

Section 3. That the sum of \$25,000.00 has been appropriated in Ordinance No. 1-80 designated as "County Contract".

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
