

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 302-80

An Ordinance to make appropriations for capital improvements during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1980.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following sums be and are set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund for use for the Recreation and Parks Department:


- a) \$350.00 for the rust prevention of a new one-half ton pickup truck; and purchase of one tool set, stock number 33177.
- b) \$1,050.00 for the purchase of eight (8) picnic tables.
- c) \$1,650.00 for seed, dirt, straw and tiling of Commonwealth Parks; additional paint for the Jeffrey Mansion restoration; and drinking fountain for Jeffrey Mansion.
- d) \$1,800.00 for concrete block wall for Jeffrey Park, to replace existing handball wall.
- e) \$3,000.00 for the purchase of "Big Toy" play equipment for Jeffrey Park.
- f) \$2,500.00 for lighting and materials for Bexley High School Tennis Courts, to be used during summer recreation programs.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


