

ORDINANCE NO. 36 -80

An Ordinance to appropriate funds and authorize bids for the repair and replacement of the heating system for the Bexley Municipal Garage.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$17,000.00 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered general fund for the purpose of contracting for the repair and replacement of the heating system for the Bexley Municipal Garage.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter a contract for said repairs, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum so specified and appropriated, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 3. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
