

ORDINANCE NO. 42-80

To provide for the purchase and installation of a new 8 inch C. T. water meter and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract with the City of Columbus for the purchase of an 8 inch C. T. master water meter and fittings; and replacement of steps and the installation of a vent at 2071 Payne Avenue.

Section 2. That the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund to cover the cost of the same and the cost of renovation of the meter pit at the Holtzman-Payne location.

Section 3. That this is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the present meter needs replacing and the master pit requires renovation as soon as possible and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
