ORDINANCE NO. 42-80 William Bellamy

To provide for the purchase and installation of a new 8 inch C. T. water meter and to declare an emergency.

Section 2. That the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund to cover the cost of the same and the cost of menovation of the meter pit at the Holtzman-Payne location.

Section 3. That this is an congency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the present meter needs replacing and the master pit requires renovation as soon as possible and this oblinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
