ORDINANCE NO. 46 -80

BN: Hoemust

An ordinance to increase the salary of the Auditor of the City of Bexley to the amount of \$12,000.00 per year, and to repeal all previous salary ordinances regarding the position of auditor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Article 5, Section 33 of the Charter of the City of Bexley provide that an auditor, who shall be the fiscal officer of the City, shall be elected for a term of four years and shall assume office on the 1st day of January next following his election; that he shall perform all the duties and exercise all powers conferred upon him by the charter, the ordinances of the City of Bexley and the general laws of the State of Ohio;

Section 2. That the salary of the auditor be increased to the total amount of \$12,000.00 per year, payable in equal monthly installments;

Section 3. That the salary increase provided by this ordinance shall be effective at the beginning of the term of office of the auditor at least one year after the effective date of this ordinance, as provided by the Charter of the City of Bexley, and that the annual salary ordinance of the City for the first year so affected and continuing thereafter be amended to reflect the increased salary;

Section 4. That all previous ordinances enacted by the Council of the City of Bexley regarding the salary of the auditor and any increases or decreases thereof which are inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed; and

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
