An ordinance to appropriate funds to reimburse a property owner for sewer repairs caused by a blockage of the main sanitary sewer line.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That in responding to a reported sewer back-up on October 25, 1980 at 678 South Roosevelt Avenue, the sanitary sewer main contiguous to the property was checked and found to be running free and clear of obstruction, the property owner, Mr. Stephen Glick, was notified and advised to call a private sewer cleaner to clear the obstruction from his sanitary sewer lateral;

Section 2 : That such service was performed by the Electra-Bore Sewer Company without success. The City was notified and a second attempt was instituted to find the problem. After considerable search it was found that the sanitary sewer lateral at 678 South Roosevelt was extended across the street to discharge into a separate sewer main located in the alley east of Vernon Road. This sanitary sewer main was cleared and the debris then drained from the basement of the Glick property;

Section 3: That the amount of \$100.00 was billed to Mr. Glick for the services of the Electra-Bore Sewer Company and paid by him and that he should be reimbursed for this expenditure by the City;

Section 4: That the sum of \$100.00 should be and it is hereby set aside, and appropriated from the Sewer Fund and the Auditor is hereby authorized to pay that amount to the property owner, or to his account, whichever is appropriate;

Section 5: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
