

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 10-85

An Ordinance to grant additional sick leave with pay to Amos Lawrence and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Amos Lawrence, a long-time employee of the City of Bexley, has been diagnosed as having severe hypertension and hypertensive cardiovascular disease; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lawrence exhausted his sick leave benefits and was granted additional sick leave for 20 work days pursuant to Ordinance No. 22-81; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lawrence has requested 32 days of additional sick leave for the period January 16 through February 28, 1985; and

WHEREAS, Council is authorized by Ordinance No. 22-81 to grant extensions of sick leave benefits, and it has been determined that it would be in the best interest of the City of Bexley to grant additional sick leave to Mr. Lawrence; Now, Therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Amos Lawrence be granted additional sick leave benefits of up to 32 work days, commencing as of January 16, 1985, and expiring no later than February 28, 1985, or the effective date of Public Employees Retirement System of Ohio g.H.S. disability retirement benefits, whichever first occurs.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
