

ORDINANCE NO. 13 -85

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to advertise for bids for the purchase of water meters for the City of Bexley, and to declare an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed after advertisement according to law, to enter into contract with the lowest and best bidder for the purchase of water meters to implement the first year of a 5 year water meter replacement program.

Section 2. The amount of \$26,000.00 has been appropriated and set aside in Ordinance No. 1-85 for this contract and that the contract, as specified, shall not exceed the balance of the appropriation.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
