

ORDINANCE NO. 14 -85

An ordinance to reappropriate funds for previously approved planning services regarding additional and expanded recreational facilities for the City of Bexley, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 52-84 authorized planning services by the City Planner for additional and expanded recreational facilities for the City of Bexley and appropriated the sum of \$7,000.00 for said study; and

WHEREAS, The contract for the planning services was properly executed and the work was commenced in 1984 but a purchase order was not issued by the Auditor's Office and the funds were not encumbered.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$7,000.00 shall be reappropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the City Planner's account to be used for recreational facilities planning services and that the City Planner shall bill the City on the same basis as for other services provided.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
