

ORDINANCE NO. 21 - 85

An Ordinance to transfer monies from the Street Construction Fund to the unencumbered General Fund, to appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the city administration has recommended, and Council has determined, that an additional position of Automotive Mechanic 1 be created for the Municipal Garage; and

WHEREAS, the Street Construction Fund contains \$18,000.00 which will not be required by it; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to fund such additional position by the transfer of monies; now, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$18,000.00 should be, and it hereby is, transferred from the Street Construction Fund to the General Fund..

Section 2. That the sum of \$18,000.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to Account No. 01-320-101.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
