

ORDINANCE NO. 26-85

An ordinance to appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$42,000 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to pay premiums on various policies of insurance required by the City in connection with its operations.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and its approval by the Mayor.
