

ORDINANCE NO. 28 - 85

An Ordinance to establish an awards program for employees of the Bexley Service Department and to appropriate funds.

WHEREAS, the Bexley Service Department Employee Committee has recommended that an employee incentive program be established to create an Employee Awards Program; and

WHEREAS, said committee has suggested that said program be established in the memory of James "Ed" Messer who had contributed over twenty-five years of honorable and faithful service to the Bexley Service Department. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That an Employee Awards Program be established in the name of James "Ed" Messer to recognize outstanding service by employees of the Bexley Service Department to the residents of the City of Bexley.

Section 2. That said Employee Awards Program shall consist of a monthly award of a letter of recognition and a twenty-five dollar cash bonus to the employee nominated by a Bexley Service Department Supervisor for outstanding service during the previous work month and that final selection will be made by the mayor based on the written nomination and that an Annual Award Winner will be selected by the Mayor in January of each year from the previous monthly award winners and that the annual award for outstanding service shall consist of a trophy and a Two-Hundred Dollar cash bonus.

Section 3. That the criteria for the James "Ed" Messer Award for Outstanding Public Service shall be based on service over and above performance standards and can include cost saving suggestions, service during times of emergency or significant work performance over an extended period of time and that where outstanding criteria has not been met there shall be no award winner.

Section 4. That the amount of Five Hundred Dollars be and is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the 1985 Outstanding Service Department Employee Awards Program.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
