

ORDINANCE NO. 32 -85

An Ordinance to appropriate additional funds to pay the costs of the 1985 Franklin County Permissive License Tax Project, to authorize the contracting for said Project, and to declare an emergency. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City of Bexley, in Ordinance No. 1-85, had previously appropriated the sum of \$44,000.00 for the Franklin County Permissive License Tax Project.

Section 2. That the total estimated costs for this Project is \$46,500.00 and that the additional sum of \$2,500.00 shall be and it is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the Street Fund.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into contracts for the 1985 Franklin County Permissive License Tax Project, which shall consist of the resurfacing of Parkview Avenue between Main Street and Broad Street with slurry seal and Gould Road from Main Street to Broad Street with asphaltic concrete.

Section 4. That the contract for Parkview Avenue shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law and that the contract for Gould Road shall be entered into with the City of Columbus as provided for by law.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
