

ORDINANCE NO. 34 -85

An Ordinance to appropriate funds and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$750 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to purchase recreational uniforms.

Section 2: That the sum of \$5,000 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the Capital Improvements Fund for replacement of the roof of the City Garage.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and, therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
