

ORDINANCE NO. 36-85

An ordinance to appropriate additional funds for the boarding of prisoners at the Franklin County Jail and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$2,000 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to be used to pay the cost of boarding of prisoners at the Franklin County Jail.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and that this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
