An Ordinance to appropriate additional funds to pay the costs of the 1985 Street Improvement Project, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, The City of Bexley, in Ordinance No. 4 - 85 had appropriated the sum of \$120,000.00 for the 1985 Street Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, The bids were received after advertisement according to law and the lowest and best bid was submitted by G & G Cement Contractor Company in the amount of \$136,706.30; and

WHEREAS, The City Council Finance Committee has recommended that the additional amount of \$16, 706.30, necessary for the award of the contract for improvements, be appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$16,706.30 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the Capital Improvements Fund and transferred to the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund to pay the additional cost of the 1985 Street Improvement Project.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
