An Ordinance to appropriate additional funds to pay the costs of purchasing a replacement truck for the Municipal Garage Truck which was totally damaged in an accident, to authorize the contract for the truck, and to delcare an emergency.

WHEREAS, The Home Insurance Company has paid the City of Bexley \$9,894.00 for settlement of the damage claim for the replacement of the Municipal Garage Truck totally damaged in a vehicular accident; and

WHEREAS, The City is in need of the replacement of said truck which is necessary for the efficient operation of the Municipal Garage; and

WHEREAS, The City Council Finance Committee has recommended that the amount necessary for purchase of the replacement truck be appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CONCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$9,894.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay the cost of the purchase of a truck for the use by the Municipal Garage, the specifications which are on file in the Office of the Mayor.

Section 2: That the contract for said purchase shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
