

ORDINANCE NO. 49 - 85

An Ordinance to appropriate additional funds to purchase and install a commercial gas range and oven for the Jeffrey Mansion, and to declare an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: that the sum of \$1,350.00 should be, and it hereby is, appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund to pay for the purchase of a replacement commercial type gas range and oven for use in the Jeffrey Mansion.

Section 2: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and therefore, such Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
