

ORDINANCE NO. 50 - 85

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to advertise for bids for the construction of a sanitary relief sewer at Parkview and Bryden, to appropriate necessary funds, and to declare an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed after advertisement according to law, to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the construction of a sanitary relief sewer at Parkview Avenue and Bryden Road.

Section 2: That the amount of \$45,000.00 be and it is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered Sewer Funds to pay for all costs related to this project including engineering fees, right-of-way acquisition, and construction labor and materials.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and, therefore, this Ordinance shall go into immediate affect upon its passage and approval.
