

ORDINANCE NO. 54 -85

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract for the lease of a replacement photocopy machine for the use of the City of Bexley, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley is presently leasing a Canon NP-400 photocopy machine which is used extensively by all departments of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the present machine is not capable of functioning efficiently at the existing level of use and is limited in the amount of features that could be used in the operation of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the funds necessary for the payment of the lease obligations have already been appropriated to the City Hall account in Ordinance No. 1-85, and that payment will be made from this account as the monthly obligation becomes due. NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a five year lease agreement with Madison Leasing Company, Inc., for the lease of a Canon 7550 photocopy machine for use by the City of Bexley and that said lease shall provide for a monthly payment not to exceed \$277.49.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
