

RESOLUTION NO. 4-81

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 40B-50 provides, inter alia, that any disabled or sick member of the Division of Police shall be entitled to draw and receive regular pay during such sickness or disability for a period of six (6) months;

WHEREAS, Section 1 of said Ordinance further provides, that upon the satisfaction of various conditions, the sick or disabled member of the Division of Police shall be continued upon the payroll of the City at the end of said six (6) month period, but for no more than three (3) consecutive thirty (30) day periods, except by resolution of council;

WHEREAS, Officer Richard Criner has drawn and received regular pay from the City of Bexley since July 19, 1980, although he was unable to work at all since that time, and that the initial 6-month sick leave under Ordinance 40B-50 would have expired on January 19, 1981, and the three (3) thirty day extension periods under said Ordinance would have expired on April 19, 1981;

WHEREAS, Officer Richard Criner is still unable to return to work and has now made application to the Police and Fire Pension Board for approval of pension for disability retirement which application is now pending; and

WHEREAS, Officer Richard Criner has informed the Mayor that he will submit his resignation from the Police Department upon final approval of his pension, but has requested an extension of his salary and benefits until such time as that is accomplished;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That this Council, pursuant to the authority provided in Ordinance 40B-50, extend full wage and salary benefits to Officer Richard Criner for a period of thirty (30) days from April 19, 1981;

Section 2: That this Council again review the disability situation and the status of Officer Criner's pension application at the end of the said thirty (30) day period to determine further action by Council.
