

RESOLUTION NO. 7-81

A resolution of Council to hold employees of the City of Bexley harmless from a finding of recovery made by the Auditor's Office, State of Ohio.

WHEREAS, a theft occurred in the Service Department, City of Bexley, during the year 1980 and approximately \$235.00 in Building Department receipts were discovered missing;

WHEREAS, the Auditor of the State of Ohio has now completed its biennial audit of the City of Bexley and as part of that audit has made a finding of recovery against two employees of the Service Department responsible for maintaining the Building Department receipts;

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Bexley has determined that the loss was not the fault of either employee and that the two employees should not be held responsible for the loss.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

1. That the Assistant Service Director for the City of Bexley and the Secretary of the Building Department, against whom the finding of recovery has been made, be held harmless by the loss of the money, and that the loss be assumed and paid for by the City out of the General Fund.

2. That this resolution be adopted and become effective at the special meeting of Council, held for this purpose, this 29th day of June, 1981.
