WHEREAS, the Franklin County Children Services Board has demonstrated the need for this levy because of an increasing demand for services, decreasing revenues, and increasing costs; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Children Services Board has made 22% cuts in programs and employee levels and will face an additional crippling cut of 27% of its programs and employees if no additional levy is passed; and

WHEREAS, this levy will only meet the project costs of maintaining current Franklin County Children Services Board's services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That this Council hereby endorses passage of the 1 6/10 mill levy to support the continuing provision of services to abused, neglected and homeless children by the Franklin County Children Services Board and will communicate this support to its citizens.
