

ORDINANCE NO. 11-81

An Ordinance to appropriate the sum of \$500.00 for the cost of the appraisal of property available for purchase from Capital University and to authorize the expenditure.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That property presently owned by Capital University is available for purchase by the City of Bexley for use for governmental purposes by the City;

Section 2: That an evaluation of the property is necessary by qualified appraisers to determine the reasonableness by any proposed transaction and that the cost of such appraisal has been estimated at no more than \$500.00;

Section 3: That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of such appraisal services to determine the value of the property in question and that the sum of \$500.00 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund to pay for said services.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
