

RESOLUTION NO. 12-81

Declaring intent to appropriate interests in real estate to provide for the operation of the municipal government and the parking of municipal employees.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the public interest to acquire the interests in land hereinafter described for the operation of the municipal building, the providing of municipal services, and the parking of municipal employees.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO.

Section 1. That it is deemed necessary and it is hereby declared to be the intention of this council to appropriate the fee simple interest in and to the real property hereinafter described for the operation of the municipal government of the City of Bexley:

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin and City of Bexley, more particularly described as follows:

Being Lot No. Eight (8), G.N. Tussing's Subdivision, as the same is numbered and delineated on the recorded plat, Plat Book 5, Page 74, in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio, except one hundred and forty-six (146) feet off the north end thereof, the excepted portion being the premises deeded to the City of Bexley on January 23, 1948, by Clara Corbett, which deed is recorded in Deed Book Volume 1419, page 177, in the Office of the Recorder, Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 719.05, Revised Code of Ohio, this resolution shall take effect immediately.
