

ORDINANCE NO. 13-81

An Ordinance to make appropriations for capital improvements during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1981, to authorize capital purchases for said year, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CCUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
OHIO:

Section 1: That the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund:

- (a) \$19,200.00 to be transferred to Account 150-8 for use for capital improvements for Jeffrey Mansion during the year 1981;
- (b) \$55,000.00 to be transferred to Account 200-5 for use for the purchase of 25 cubic yard capacity rubbish packer by the Refuse Department;
- (c) \$5,000.00 to be transferred to Account 400-5 for use for the purchase of a new or used street roller for street maintenance;

Section 2: That the Mayor or Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of a 25 cubic yard capacity rubbish packer mounted on a diesel truck chassis, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum of \$55,000.00, specified and appropriated above, plus the trade-in of a 1974 Ford Packer Truck, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor;

Section 3: That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the purchase of a new or used street roller, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum of \$5,000.00 specified and appropriated above, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor;

Section 4: Said contracts, when required by law, shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law;

Section 5: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
