

ORDINANCE NO. 16 -81

An Ordinance to authorize bids for the repair and resurfacing of the entrance drive for the Jeffrey Mansion.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 13-81, which was adopted by this council on March 10, 1981, for the purposes of making appropriations for capital improvements during the fiscal year ending December 31, 1981, included, at Section 1 (a), an appropriation for \$19,200.00 for use for capital improvements for Jeffrey Mansion which included an amount of \$9,500.00 for repairs and resurfacing of the entrance drive.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for said work, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum so specified and appropriated, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 3. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
