

ORDINANCE NO. 25 -81

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract with Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., as architects for the remodeling of the existing police department and jail facilities, and to appropriate funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract with Karlsberger and Associates, Inc., 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, for professional services as ARCHITECT, INTERIOR DESIGNER, and GRAPHIC DESIGNER for the project of remodeling the existing police department and jail facilities, a copy of which contract is attached hereto and made a part hereof and incorporated herein, as if fully rewritten;

Section 2: That the sum of \$27,500.00 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund for the purposes of paying for said services as they become due under the terms of said contract.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
