An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to enter into an agreement with Blue Cross-Blue Shield and with Delta Dental Plan, through the City of Columbus Fraternal Order of Police health and dental insurance programs, for all employees of the City of Bexley, and to terminate existing Blue Cross-Blue Shield health and dental programs.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into an agreement with Blue Cross-Blue Shield and with Delta Dental Plan, through the program established for the Fraternal Order of Police, City of Columbus, for health and dental insurance for all employees of the City of Bexley;

Section 2: That said agreement for said insurance coverages shall become effective as provided in the terms of the agreement, but as soon as possible, and that the Mayor and Auditor be, and they also are, hereby authorized and directed to terminate any and all contracts now existing for health and dental insurance for City of Bexley employees as of the effective date of the new programs;

Section 3: That all funds previously appropriated into Account 170-5 for health insurance purposes, and still remaining in said account as of the effective date of this Ordinance, be re-appropriated and set aside for the purposes of paying the monthly premiums of the new insurance programs;

Section 4: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
