

ORDINANCE NO. 28 -81

An ordinance to appropriate funds for the purchase of emergency barricades and lights and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered General Fund and transferred to the Street Maintenance and Repair Fund for the purpose of purchasing forty-eight emergency barricades equipped with flashing light assemblies.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
