

ORDINANCE NO. 29 -81

An Ordinance to appropriate funds for the purchase of one (1) three (3) inch meter and one (1) four (4) inch meter for use at Capital University.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of Two Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Eight Dollars and Eighty-Three cents (\$2,558.83) be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the Water Fund.

- a) \$958.64 for the purchase of a three (3) inch meter for the Athletic Field at Capital University.
- b) \$1,600.19 for the purchase of a four (4) inch meter for 2311 E. Mound Street (Schoedinger Dorm) at Capital University.

Section 2. That the above equipment is for resale to Capital University.

Section 3. That it is necessary to appropriate additional money to the replacement meter account of the Water Fund so as not to deplete this account with large purchases for major re-alignment of water services to existing construction.
