

ORDINANCE NO. 36 -81

An ordinance to appropriate funds to the Distribution Account, No. 500-13, for continued water meter replacement during calendar year 1981 and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Water Department, City of Bexley has been replacing obsolete water meters used by property owners in the City of Bexley and that although the property owner, in many instances, pays for the cost of the replacement and such money when received by the City is deposited in the Water Fund, such money is not attributed to the specific account used to pay for the original purchase.

Section 2. That there presently is only \$447.52 remaining in the account used for the purchases and that an additional \$2,000.00 will be needed to continue the replacement program through the remainder of 1981.

Section 3. That the sum of \$2,000.00 be appropriated and set aside from the unencumbered Water Fund and transferred to the Distribution Account, No. 500-13, Meters, to be used by the Water Department for their purchase requirements for the remainder of calendar year 1981.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
