

ORDINANCE NO. 5 -82

To authorize the Mayor to purchase a new or used car to replace a wrecked police cruiser and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to enter into a contract without advertising and bidding, for the purchase of a 1982 Ford LTD, 4 door sedan with air conditioning, power steering, power brakes, automatic transmission, and such other equipment as may be selected by the Mayor to replace the police cruiser which was demolished in a recent accident, and the maximum amount that may be paid as the purchase price for the same is hereby determined to be \$8,863.71.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the City is without the necessary number of operating police cruisers, and this ordinance may go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
