

ORDINANCE NO. 6-82

Authorizing the purchase of materials for the maintenance and repair of streets for the balance of the year, 1982 and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed after advertisement according to law, to enter into contracts with the lowest and best bidders for the purchase and delivery of the following materials for the maintenance and repair of the various streets and avenues in the City of Bexley for the balance of the year, 1982, to wit:

Bituminous Concrete -- 150 Tons

Cement Concrete -- 300 Cubic Yards

Section 2: That the amount of \$15,000.00 has been appropriated and set aside from the Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund, in Ordinance No. 1-82 for the purchase of said materials and that the contracts, as specified in Section 1, shall not exceed this amount.

Section 3: That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, said emergency being that this material is necessary for the adequate operation of the Street Department, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
