

ORDINANCE NO. 7 -82

An Ordinance to appropriate funds and authorize the purchase of two satellite refuse collection vehicles for use by the Sanitation Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the sum of \$7,400.00 be and it is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered Refuse Fund for the purpose of purchasing two (2) three-wheel satellite refuse collection vehicles for use by the Sanitation Department.

Section 2: That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a purchase contract for said items, the total cost of which shall not exceed the sum so specified and appropriated, and the complete specifications for which have been prepared and are on file in the Office of the Mayor.

Section 3: That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 4: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
