

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 8-82

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 6-81 regarding the charges for water and sewer usage in the City of Bexley and to set new rates as of April, 1982, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 6-81, passed March 10, 1981, provided that water and sewer rates be established by Council upon the advise of the Water Department and dependent upon the needs of the City, be amended;

Section 2: That the water rate charged by the City of Bexley on all bills issued after the date of this Ordinance shall be \$8.70 per 1000 cubic feet (MCF);

Section 3: That the sewer rate charged by the City of Bexley on all bills issued after the date of this Ordinance shall be \$11.15 per 1000 cubic feet (MCF);

Section 4: That all existing Ordinances of the City of Bexley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance;

Section 5: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
