

AMENDED
ORDINANCE NO. 11-82

BY:

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor to solicit bids for furnishing all materials and performing all labor for the remodeling and addition to the Police Headquarters Building in accordance with the Drawings and Specifications prepared by Karlsberger and Associates, Inc. and pursuant to the bidding requirements and procedure set forth in The Project Manual 1012A and the applicable state law, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That by contract, previously authorized, the City entered into an agreement with the firm of Karlsberger and Associates, Inc. to provide architectural services for the remodeling and addition to the Police Headquarters Building and that part of those services was to provide bidding requirements and specifications for the furnishing of all materials and labor for the project;

Section 2: That said bidding requirements, instructions and supplementary instructions have now been furnished and incorporated into The Project Manual; including drawings, specifications, and other documents, and that the City, through the Mayor, is now prepared to advertise for bids to be received no later than ~~2:00 P.M.~~ ^{12:00 Noon} Tuesday, March 9, 1982, and read aloud immediately thereafter;

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 17, 1982

Section 3: That this Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to solicit bids for the remodeling and addition to the Police Headquarters Building pursuant to the Charter of the City of Bexley, and applicable state law, and that such solicitation conform to the requirements, instructions and supplementary instructions and forms set forth in The Project Manual prepared and furnished to the City by the said architects.

Section 4: That this Ordinance is an emergency Ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
