

ORDINANCE NO. 15-82

To amend the provisions of Ordinance 41-81 regarding the schedule of fees to be charged by the Building Department and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the following subparagraph be inserted between subparagraphs (B) and (C) of Section 1 and that subparagraph (C) be changed to read subparagraph (D):

(C) Electrical Permits:

1. The basic fee for an electrical permit shall be three dollars (\$3.00) plus the following: minimum fee \$16.00; outlets, fixtures, receptacles or switches \$.40 each; appliances \$1.50 each; service, per ampere \$.05; special trip for permanent or temporary service \$16.00.

2. If more than one inspection is necessary because of faulty construction or an additional trip is caused by improper address or locked premises, an additional charge of \$16.00 minimum per trip not to exceed double the inspection fee will be charged for each inspection.

Section 2: That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
