An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 7-82 by increasing the total appropriations for the purchase of two satellite refuse collection vehicles for use by the Sanitation Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 7-82, which was adopted by this Council on March 8, 1982, included, in Section 1, an appropriation for \$7,400.00 for the purchase of two satellite refuse collection vehicles;

Section 2. That pursuant to said Ordinance, the contract specifications were advertised and bids were received, and that it has now been determined that it will cost additional monies of \$8,231.00 to purchase said equipment with the desired and necessary accessories;

Section 3. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 7-82 should be, and it hereby is, amended by increasing the sum appropriated from \$7,400.00 to \$15,631.00, and such additional sum is hereby set aside and appropriated from the unencumbered Refuse Fund for use of the Sanitation Department.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
